Hi Jeremy,

I'm reaching out from the SFCTA with an fyi that may or may not be relevant to your Hayes Public Life study:

I happened to catch your item at the TA Board a couple of weeks ago (congrats on getting funded!) and the presentation reminded me of something Lloyd Silverstein, president of the Hayes Valley Merchant Association, shared during a working group meeting for my agency's recently completed [Eco-Friendly Downtown Deliveries Study](#). The working group was discussing the idea of an Off-Hours Delivery Program and Lloyd spoke about how he saw the program as a key to unlocking operational changes for Hayes. He believed that shifting deliveries to off hours could mitigate a key pain point and expand possibilities on Hayes.

The final report did eventually recommend piloting an off-hours-delivery program.
